

# AMBASSADOR JOB DESCRIPTION

## Qualifications

Ambassadors must be in at least 7<sup>th</sup> grade at the beginning of the 2018-19 school year. They need to be an active 4-H member. They must attend the interviews on Thursday, October 4 from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m., and be willing and able to commit to meetings and activities throughout the year. ## Ambassador Term

Ambassadors are selected in October. Once they are chosen, they start their 1 year term which concludes at Ambassador selection the following year. All of the Ambassadors serving during these consecutive years will be recognized at the Leader's Banquet or your club Banquet which are typically held in the fall of each year. Ambassadors may be selected for more than one term.
