This event will provide 4-Hers the opportunity to engage with leaders in the creation and making a variety of cultural art projects! Projects at this event may include the use of tools and equipment. Therefore, any attendee under the age of 10 must be accompanied by a Junior Leader (8th grade and up) or an adult. The cost for members to attend is \$10 and includes a boxed lunch. If you are an attending adult or junior leader, you must also register and provide the \$10 registration fee to cover the cost of lunch.

Each member will be able to participate in three classes. You will have the opportunity to participate in a community service project as well as participate in a “cultural arts judging session”. Finally – bring those unwanted arts and crafts supplies and put them into the material exchange. Bring some items you no longer need and then find and take some items you are interested in. This is a swap event only and no items will be sold.
