Congregate Dining / Senior Meals

Available to individuals aged 60 or older, an underage spouse of an eligible participant, a caregiver or disabled person who lives with an eligible senior and accompanies them to a meal site, or a disabled person that lives in a housing unit that hosts a meal site and is occupied mostly by seniors. Suggested donation of \$3.50 per meal to defray costs is appreciated. No one over 60 will be denied a meal due to inability to donate. Call to reserve your meal 24 hours in advance. • **Economic Support:** Provides the following income based services: FoodShare, BadgerCare, Family Planning Only Services, Medical Assistance, Family Care, Wisconsin Shares Child Care Subsidy Program, Caretaker Supplement, and the Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP). ACESS, the Great Rivers Call Center, and Centralized Document Processing Unit (CDPU) each play a role in facilitating these services to individuals.

ACCESS: provides up-to-date information and online applications for the following: SeniorCare, Medicaid/BadgerCare, FoodShare, Family Planning Services, and Caretaker Supplement benefits. Visit <u>http://access.wi.gov/</u> to apply.

Great Rivers Call Center: Staffed by Economic Support Specialists from ten counties, which makes up the Great Rivers Consortium. Individuals call 1-888-283-0012 to ask questions or schedule an appointment with an Economic Support Specialist in their county to discuss Income Maintenance Programs.

Centralized Document Processing Unit (CDPU): Individuals applying for Income Maintenance Programs will be required to submit verification documents via fax to 1-855-293-1822. Free/Reduced Cost School Meals

Contact your local School District Office for an application. All schools have a free/reduced cost meal program for children. Families on Food Share, BadgerCare, or medical assistance are eligible. ALL families need to complete an application.

Meals on Wheels

Available to individuals who are 60 years or older, homebound due to health reasons, and are unable to prepare a nutritious meal on their own. There is suggested donation of \$4 per meal, but any amount will be gratefully accepted. No senior will go hungry due to inability to pay. At the end of the month a statement will be sent with the number of meals received. Call the Dunn County ADRC at 715-232-4006 to register for the program.

Offers emergency shelter, housing assistance and referral services. They also operate a food pantry, which is open Mondays, Thursdays, and Fridays from 11 am- 2 pm, Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 3 pm- 6 pm, and Saturdays from 10 am- noon. They are closed Sundays. To use the food pantry, individuals need to bring a photo ID, proof of Dunn County residency (driver's license, utility bill, lease, etc.) and know your household's gross monthly income.

Beginning Today, Tuesday, March 17, Stepping Stones Food Pantry will be doing ALL food distribution as curbside pick-up of pre-packed bags/boxes only. Boxes will be sized for families of 2. If there are more in your household, we will give you additional boxes. If you are a household of one, we hope you may not need to leave home as often! Boxes will be available for pick up during our normal food pantry hours: Mondays, Thursdays and Friday from 11:00 -2:00 Tuesday and Wednesday from 3:00-6:00 and Saturdays from 10:00- Noon The curbside pickup will take place at the sliding doors on the east side of the Stepping Stones building. There will be volunteers in the parking lot to direct you and to load your box(es) into your car. There will be no need to leave your vehicle. Please enter from 17th Street and exit onto Stout Road. Do NOT park in a parking spot — just pull up behind any other cars already in line. There is no advantage to coming early and waiting longer as all boxes will have the same quantity and types of food. We suggest you come at least an hour after the scheduled start time if you want to avoid what could be a lengthy wait. A volunteer will take your name and family size. You may roll down your car window to give the volunteer this information or hold your I.D. up to the window and indicate the # with your fingers. When you reach the sliding doors, either pop your trunk or have your back door unlocked for a volunteer to load your box(es). If your trunk needs to be unlocked, please stay in your car and hand the volunteer your keys. We ask you to try to only come as needed and not more than once per week so we can keep enough food on hand for everyone who

needs it. If you are on foot or bike, you can come more often and walk up to the sliding doors for your food package.
