Welcome to the 2022 Training Season! Records indicate that your private pesticide applicator certification may be expiring soon. Please check your certification card to identify when your certification ends or go to the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer protection's web site and look yourself up or have someone help you. http://www.kellysolutions.com/WI/Applicators/index.asp

If your certification is not expiring or you do not plan to buy or use Restricted Use Pesticides, please disregard this letter.

To get certified or recertified in Wisconsin:

- **1. Required:** You must purchase the base training fee with manual (book). This is \$30.00.
- 2. Required: You must take and pass the certification test (General Farming, Fruit Crops or Greenhouse & Nursery).
- **3. Training:** You can do 1 and 2 above (self-study) and pass the test getting at least 70% or you can take one of the additional training options, online computer-based training or attend an in-person training and then pass the test getting at least 50%.

There are three options you can choose from for training:

You can self-study on your own and schedule a test with your participating County Extension Office. Passing grade is 70%.

- Training Option 1 and 2 please contact your participating County Extension Office. Passing grade is 50%.
- Training Option 3: the test is given at the end of the training. Passing grade is 50%.

Things to Bring to the Exam:

- Photo ID. The exam proctor will not issue you an exam without positive ID (such as a driver's license).
- Social Security number. Federal and State law require this number from anyone who is seeking a state certification or license.
- Your training manual. Complete the Training Registration Form that immediately follows the front cover of the manual and turn it in to the exam proctor. The WDATCP cannot grade your exam, nor grant you certification, until the form is collected.
- **Calculator.** You may use a calculator for the exam. However, cell phone calculators, programmable calculators, or those with alphabet keypads are **NOT** permitted.
