- 3. Bring the club scrapbook to the Home Environment Judge to be judged by 7:00 PM on Wednesday, July 19th.
 - All scrapbooks will receive a ribbon, but the top 3 will receive special recognition.




Criteria:

- Include only information from the current year in the scrapbook Fair to Fair time frame.
- The scrapbook will be conference judged in the Youth Leadership Dept. on Wednesday during conference judging time.



FAIR ENTRIES

FAIR ENTRY CHANGES

Entries for the 2023 St. Croix County Fair have closed, and no changes can be made unless it has to do with an animal illness. If you have an animal issue, please contact the species department head for instructions on changing that entry.

ENTRY TAG PICK UP

Fair Office Building (Building # 1) on Saturday, July 15th 10:00 AM until 3:00 PM or Wednesday, July 19th 11:00 AM until 7:30 PM and small animal tags only on Thursday, July 20th 8:00 AM until 7:30 PM

There are no tags for Dairy, Beef, Swine, Sheep, Goats, Horses and Dogs.

Before going to the judge, attach the tags to your entries with the Claim Check torn off the bottom of the tag. Finally, fold the tag over your name, so it is not showing. Be sure to save your Claim Check Tags! You will need them on Sunday to pick up your entries.

Take your exhibit to the project table to be judged. Judging locations are posted at the fairgrounds, in the back of the fair book, and in the fair newsletter. Following judging, take your item(s) to the scanners to have your placing scanned and a ribbon attached to your entry tag. Finally, take your entry to the correct building to have it displayed with the other exhibits from that department. Remember to save your claim check.

Pick up is Sunday, July 23rd, 4:00 PM until 7:00 PM, and Monday July 24th, 8:00 AM until 11:00 AM. If you do not pick up your exhibits, they will be disposed of at the discretion of the fair board.

If you no longer have your entry email confirmation and you have forgotten what you entered, follow the instruction below:

- Go to www.FairEntry.com and select "Find your Fair" State map and pick Wisconsin
- Scroll down to St. Croix County Fair 2023
- Sign in with your 4-H Online account using the Green Tab or if you used a FairEntry account use the Blue Tab
- Pick the account you are looking for
- In "Completed Invoice" click "View"
- Right Click and choose "Print"


