


Commodity Supplemental Food Program

Qualified seniors aged 60+ have access to food resources including:

- * Hot, nutritious meals at **Senior Dining Sites** in Amery and Milltown.
- * **Meal delivery** if unable to visit dining sites, cook for themselves or have someone else prepare meals for them.
