

The University of Wisconsin-Madison, Division of Extension grants 4-H Charters which formally authorizes a Wisconsin 4-H Club or Group to use the 4-H Name and Emblem for educational purposes in accordance with laws and regulations established by Congress and the U.S. Department of Agriculture. In addition, the 4-H Charter Application provides:

- Documentation of educational activities of the 4-H Club or Group/Committee needed for liability coverage for 4-H volunteers and members
- Program impact evaluation and educational planning
- Documentation of compliance by 4-H Clubs and Groups with EEO, ADA guidelines, and Civil Rights laws.

On Saturday September 14, 7 handler/dog teams competed in Rally Obedience and Agility at the Overdale Canine Sports facility in Spring Valley. This new and growing sport offered through the dog project takes teams further, fostering a deeper level of training and handling. Rally Obedience is where dog and handler go through a course with command signs. The handler is judged on accuracy of completing each sign and time to complete the entire course.

The agility competition consisted of three courses: Jumps-Table-Tunnel, Standard Agility no weaves, and Standard Agility. Teams competed based on their skill level. Handler/dog teams run through a course with obstacles and are judged on completion of each obstacle and time to complete the course.

Native Prairie Classes

Classroom Presentation: Saturday, October 19th. 10:30 am to 12 pm at the Deer Park Public Library

This session will be lead by Alex Bouthilet, Assistant Manager of the Star Prairie Seed Nursery and will include a presentation on prairie, oak savannas and the value of native prairie plant. It will also include a tour of the plantings established at the library with time for questions.

Field Experience: Tuesday, October 22nd. 4:30 pm to 7:30 pm at the Star Prairie Seed Nursery (1616 County Road H, Star Prairie)

The second session will focus on a tour of the nursery and information about how the seed is collected and cleaned, then used for public lands. It will include time gathering seed with volunteers out on the seed farm prairie. Information on how and what to gather will be given. Please wear clothing appropriate for tall grass and walking in prairie. No open toed shoes. Long pants are most comfortable, a hat or sunglasses and sunscreen might be needed. Insect repellant is recommended based on your own needs. There is a porta potty available but not potable water for drinking
