

2025 St. Croix County 4-H Scholarships

The St. Croix County 4-H Leaders Association scholarships are awarded to 4-Hers based on demonstrated personal growth, development and leadership, academic performance, community engagement, and future educational goals. To be considered for financial support, all applications must be emailed as indicated below no later than **Tuesday, April 1 at 5:00pm**. Late applications cannot be considered. Applications are required to follow all guidelines as outlined below. Any application that does not meet these requirements cannot be considered.

The application requirements represent what youth may be asked to submit when applying for jobs. We encourage applicants to treat this process as if applying for employment. For help with creating cover letters and resumes, applicants should reach out to their club leaders, teachers or parents.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a 4-H Scholarship, youth are required to be a member of the St. Croix County 4-H program for at least the past 3 years; be a member in good standing; have a grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale; and be enrolled or planning to enroll at a university, college, or technical school during the 2025 – 2026 academic school year.

Scholarship winners from previous years are not eligible to receive a second scholarship. Those applying for a forgivable loan may apply multiple years as long as the requirements above are met.

APPLICATION

Complete applications are to be submitted to Nicole Cash, 4-H Program Educator, at the following email address nicole.cash@wisc.edu. Applications should be submitted as one PDF document and titled as follows “Last Name Scholarship Application” (i.e. **Smith Scholarship Application**). Unfortunately, we are unable to accept any other document format or cloud/internet shared documents (i.e. Google Docs). Applications can also be mailed to UW-Extension Office, 1960 8th Avenue, Suite 140, Baldwin, WI 54002 and must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2025.

Applications must include all sections below (Cover Letter, Resume, Project List, Essay Question, Letter of Recommendation). NOTE: The letter of recommendation should be emailed separately to nicole.cash@wisc.edu by the 4-H leader writing the letter. **IMPORTANT- Each individual section should not exceed one page and should include the Applicant’s Name at the top of each page.**

1. Cover Letter

Cover letters should be your introduction and provide information relevant to the application, including how 4-H has made an impact in your life and how skills learned in 4-H will be used in the future. The strongest cover letters expand on information on the resume and do not repeat the same information. Make sure to indicate which scholarship you are applying for (4-H Scholarship, Betty Jean Utecht Forgivable Loan, 4-H Trade Scholarship or Dairy Science Scholarship).

2. Resume

Suggested resume headings include: Career Goals, Education Goals, School Experience, Current GPA,

Work Experience (paid or unpaid), 4-H Experience, Leadership Experience, Activities Outside of 4-H

3. List of all 4-H projects in which the applicant participated:

The project list should be in order of importance to the 4-Her using the template below (similar to page 2 of the green 4-H cover) with the most important projects at the top of the list.

4. Essay Question (250 word limit):

What has 4-H taught you and how has it impacted/shaped the person you are today?

5. Letter of Recommendation – Make sure the 4-H leader writing your letter is aware of the requirements below.

- One letter of recommendation from a 4-H Leader (i.e. Club leader, Project Leader). This letter should not be from a family member.
- The letter of recommendation should be emailed directly to nicole.cash@wisc.edu in a PDF format and titled as follows “Applicant’s Last Name Recommendation Letter” (i.e. **Smith Recommendation Letter**). Unfortunately, we are unable to accept any other document format or cloud/internet shared documents (i.e. Google Docs).

NOTIFICATION

Applicants who are awarded scholarships will be notified by postal letter after May 1.
