



## Become a Certified Instructor – Support our Youth

Adult instructors are always needed in teaching roles in our county shooting sports programs. The current instructors teaching kids in our shooting sports programs recognized a few years ago that this educational training must continue. They asked about being certified, attended training and began a very rewarding role of teaching and mentoring youth. Having a complete understanding of shooting sports equipment is helpful but many adults are certified each year with limited or no shooting sports experience. When you attend a certification workshop, you gain a basic understanding of the equipment and learn how to run shooting activities. Then teamteaching with instructors in your county builds your confidence and knowledge. Ask those individuals who lead shooting sports in your county how you can support shooting sports for our youth by becoming a 4-H Shooting Sports leader or instructor.



The Living Memorial Award is meant for an individual who puts a lot of time and effort into the County Fair to make it a success each year. Non 4-H Leaders as well as 4-H Leaders are eligible. 
The next **Dairy Committee Meeting** will be held on **July 7th** at the Fairgrounds at 7:00 pm.

#### 9. PREPARING YOUR EXHIBIT:

- i. One entry per poster board, unless noted in entry (i.e. story/before & after). Securely mount photos on WHITE POSTER/TAG BOARD ONLY using strong double-sided tape, be generous. NO foam core/foam board, embellishments or decorations, captions or titles, frames or photo corners. Remember to turn off the date-stamp setting on your camera. Photos can be no larger than 5 x 7 (unless otherwise noted). Cropping is acceptable and encouraged. ALL PHOTOS SHOULD BE MOUNTED ON AN 8.5" X 11" SHEET OF TAG BOARD, NOT CARD STOCK.
- ii. PHOTOS NOT PROPERLY MOUNTED WILL BE LOWERED BY ONE RIBBON.
- iii. The following must be included ON BACK OF EACH ENTRY:

Exhibitor Name, Date photo was taken Type of camera used, Years in project Explanation how trick photo or alteration was done

## Clarification for 3rd grade exhibitors

3rd graders are limited to one animal, in one animal species for a total of one animal. 3rd graders may exhibit the animal in showmanship and the appropriate lot. They must be enrolled in that animal project and follow all rules assigned to that project. It is their responsibility to follow all health requirements, rules and regulations.

## 2025 ST. CROIX COUNTY FAIR ENTRY

The 2025 St. Croix County Fair is fast approaching, "Making Memories since 1910" will be a great time on our fairgrounds. Please remember that to exhibit at the fair and showcase the projects you have been preparing, you must enter the fair between April 1st and May 31st. This entry process is done online at FairEntry.com or through your online 4H website. Your information should transfer from 4H online but if it doesn't it is easy to make a new account, but you will have to add all your information again. Things to remember:

- Make sure that all your information is correct and make necessary changes as needed. Check name, address, phone, email, club and parents. This is important incase we need to contact you
- Enter all your exhibits before submitting, making sure you are using the correct departments for the project you have entered. Also remember Youth can only enter in Departments 1-33, Education Dept. 35 is for youth not enrolled in a county youth program and Adults can enter in appropriate Open and Senior Citizens Departments 108 -162
- ENTER EVERYONE IN YOUR FAMILY BEFORE SUBMITTING. If you enter the first person and submit, you will not be able to enter the rest without making a phone call to Cindy and waiting for her to open your entry.
- Your entries will be checked, and if there is a problem, sent back to you to fix the mistakes and you will have to submit again
- Once you submit, you will receive an email from FairEntry confirming that you have entered.
- When your entries have been approved, you will receive a second email with a list of confirmed entries.
   PRINT THIS LIST SO YOU WILL HAVE A LIST OF YOUR ENTRIES (incase you forget) AND FORWARD THIS EMAIL
   TO YOUR GENERAL LEADER SO THEY WILL ALSO HAVE A LIST OF YOUR ENTRIES. This will prevent a phone call in July to ask what you have entered.
- There will be no changes to entries after May 31st unless it involves an animal illness. All animal changes have to be approved by the species department head
- Entry tags will be available at the fair office in Glenwood City on Saturday, July 12, at 10 AM 3 PM. There
  are no tags for Dairy, Beef, Swine, Sheep, Goats and Horses. All tags must be attached to projects before
  they can be judged
- Check judging schedules that will be posted closer to the fair. Bring your entries to the appropriate judges, receive your placing, have your results scanned and then place your items in the appropriate display areas.
   If you cannot be at the scheduled judging time, an absentee judging form is available so that someone else can bring your items
- Your projects can be picked up on Sunday, July 20th, 4 PM 7 PM or Monday July 21st, 9 AM 11 AM

## Who can enter?

Any active 4-H members in grades 3-13.

## When is the contest?

The contest will be open no later than March 1st and will close on April 1st at 11:59 pm.

## How do I enter my photos?

The contest will run through **4-H online.** Contest guidelines and how to upload your photo will be available through the 4-H online portal. Use this link: <u>https://25StatewidePhotoContest.4honline.com</u> to go to the contest. If you need accommodations, see your County Extension office and they can help you enter your photos.

## Categories

This year members will be able to enter photos in the following categories...

1. 4-H Themed

1. Textures

2. People

- 2. Landscape
- 3. Animals/Wildlife
- 3. Black and White only

You may enter one photo in each category. **Photos must be taken in the last 12 months and be the work of the member.** 

## **Entry fees**

**Each photo entry will cost the member \$3.00.** The cost of the entry fee helps to pay for the printing, mounting and displaying of the photos. Any excess funds will support other 4-H arts activities.

## Awards

Each photo will be judged by a group of skilled photographers. The top photo in each category will be printed, mounted and displayed at the State 4-H office, be a part of the 4-H State Art show at Summer Academy, shared on the Wisconsin 4-H social media sites, and available for display at other statewide events. Each category winner will be eligible for recognition for the overall best photo. Top photos will be used to promote the 2026 contest.

## **Copyright and Photo Releases**

Each photographer will need to give 4-H permission to print, share and display your photos. Upon selection, permission is given only for public display, social media and any promotion for Wisconsin 4-H. Proper artist credit is always given. **You retain the rights to your photos**. <u>UW-Talent Release Form</u>

Any photo with people in it will need the photographer to secure permission from the subjects. This is important so that we have the permission to share pictures of your subjects. You may opt out of having your photos shared on social media but still will need to secure permission for your photos to be displayed.

## Why enter?

Having your work judged is a great way to build your skills as a photographer. You will engage in taking better pictures, evaluating your work based on what makes a good photo, set goals for future photos, and reflect on comments that can help you improve for next time. It is also a good way to practice for the fair. If you are in the photography project it is a good idea to have your work evaluated.


