

REMINDERS:

- Reminder that all dairy exhibitors must complete the YQCA and submit a completion certificate when bringing their animal to the fair. If you do not have a certificate, you will not be able to show and your animal(s) will have to return home.
- All dairy exhibitors will be required to collect animal waste on their way to and from the show ring as well as for the time waiting to enter the show ring. Please plan accordingly as you prepare for the fair.

DRESS-A-CALF: When: July 18, 12:30 pm Where: Front of Sheep Barn @ 2025 St. Croix County Fair

Let your imagination run wild as you plan your theme for this year's Dress a Calf portion of the fair. To participate in this event, you must include it on your Fair Project Registration (Department 1, Class I, Lot 1).

This is open to all 4-H Clubs, FFA Chapters or any youth group from St. Croix County exhibiting dairy animals in the Junior Fair Show. The animals must be fall Animal Sciences 8 heifer calves or younger. There may be more than one entry from a club or group.





Reminder about HPAI (H5N1)

RE: State Order of June 19, 2024 remains in effect regarding Lactating Dairy Cattle

All lactating dairy cattle are required to receive a negative test for Influenza A virus prior to intrastate or interstate movement to fairs or exhibitions. This requirement does not apply to lactating beef cattle or nonlactating dairy cattle.

Lactating dairy cattle attending Wisconsin fairs or exhibitions are included in the state order and are required to have a negative test for Influenza A virus prior to movement.

Wisconsin is not accepting bulk tank milk results or state status for movement to fairs and exhibitions.

There have been no detections of HPAI (H5N1) in cattle in Wisconsin. Although there have been poultry flocks affected by HPAI in Wisconsin since 2022, none have been detected with the B3.13 genotype that has been detected in dairy herds in other states. A positive (sometimes called non-negative) result in cattle in Wisconsin would be reported by DATCP at the county level.

Signs must be in place no later than end of day, Sunday, June 29, 2025 and remain up through July 20, 2025.

All 4-H Clubs, FFA, FHA and other organized youth groups in St. Croix County are invited to participate in the Promote the Fair Contest. Signs promoting the fair may be put up in any prominent indoor/outdoor location in St. Croix County. Be sure to get property owners permission! This is an opportunity for major Community Service as well as an outlet to display creative talents! Prizes: 1st Place -\$125, 2^{nd-} \$100, 3rd-\$75. The sign can be any size, keeping in mind bright colors and large print have the best visibility. The sign must be easily seen by the public as they are passing by and must be in a prominent location (intersections, lot corners, town entrances, building walls, etc.). Please make sure the sign is properly fastened and upright, making sure it won't get blown over.

The Rules are simple:

• The display <u>MUST</u> include **ALL** of the following words:

St. Croix County Fair; Glenwood City, WI; and Dates of the Fair, including year.

- Be in a prominent location
- Any type of material or size
- Be easily seen by the public
- Utilize theme of the Fair for better score
